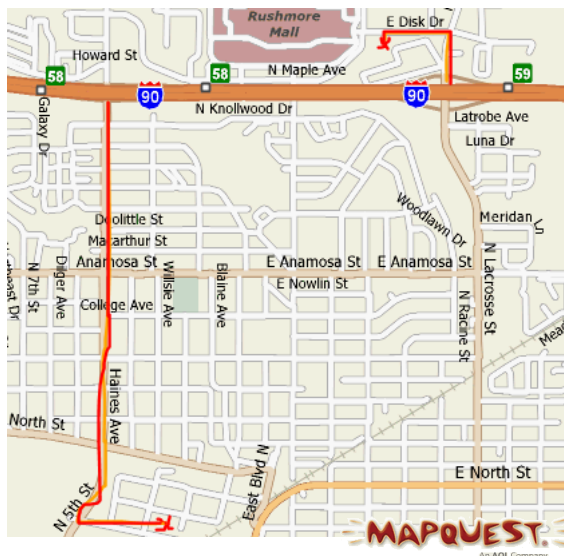

**Directions to Convention Center II from Interstate 90 (west side entrance)**

Take Exit 59 and turn north onto LaCrosse. Turn left onto E Disk Drive (at the stoplight). Take the first left into the Convention Center Parking Lot.

**Directions to The Journey Museum from Interstate 90**

Take Exit 58 and turn south onto Haines, which turns into 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Go 14 blocks. Turn left onto New York St (at the stoplight). Go 1 block and The Journey will be on your left.
