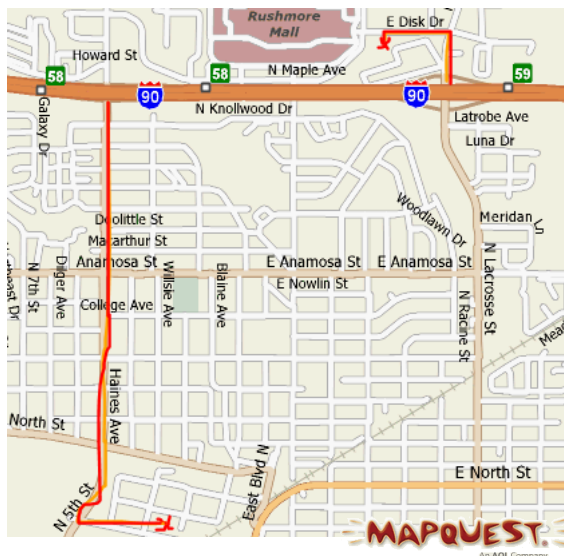

Directions to Convention Center II from Interstate 90 (west side entrance)

Take Exit 59 and turn north onto LaCrosse. Turn left onto E Disk Drive (at the stoplight). Take the first left into the Convention Center Parking Lot.

Directions to The Journey Museum from Interstate 90

Take Exit 58 and turn south onto Haines, which turns into 5th Street. Go 14 blocks. Turn left onto New York St (at the stoplight). Go 1 block and The Journey will be on your left.
